Think about what you're worried about, consider what options are available, and then combine people and routines to set them up to get outcomes.



Ensure you and those you trust, are alerted to leaks, fire, smoke or poor air quality, or unsecured doors or windows.


CONTROL HOME & APPLIANCES

We have a large screen clock to help with medication. We have some kind of camera on the front door, because we have more help dropping in so my daughter can make sure that happens as planned. We also have one by the hall table facing up the stairs where our bedroom is. She checks each night that we've made it up the stairs ok, and that there's movement in the morning.

Sometimes she drops over to check, if we've had a bit of a cold or something and have slept late. My husband's been in hospital a lot lately, so it's especially helped us all feel ok. Marvellous really. (Name supplied).

When I was my mom's caregiver, I had to hire professional caregivers to help me out as there were times that I was just lost in what to do. I gave out a lot of house keys and, sometimes, with very short notice, I'd give a caregiver the boot – never to see my key again. After a few visits with my locksmith, it dawned on me that one of these keyless door locks would be what we needed.

As I hired new caregivers, I'd set a code for them and, as they quit or I fired them, I just deleted their individual key code. Voila! My home was instantly secure again!

Get family or friends together, install the app, give access and set alerts and notifications for who can check in, and who's notified of movement, smoke etc. Make a note to check power and software upgrades from time to time. Deliberately set off alarms etc to ensure the plan is ready to go!
